2020 Raffle Quilt - The Sampler

The 2020 Raffle Quilt is made up of 6-inch finished blocks supplied by the guild members. They will be set on point with tan triangles included with these instructions.

Each member will make a 6-inch finished block of her choice. Pieced, paper-pieced, appliqu , etc. The blocks just need to finish to 6 inches*

* the block will measure 6 1/2 inches and with the 1/4 inch seam allowances it will finish to 6 inches

Instructions:

- Make a 6-inch finished block from your own pattern or from the resources listed
- Two tan triangles have been supplied, attach the first one to the block from the 12 o'clock to 9 o'clock positions and the other one from the 6 o'clock to 3 o'clock positions



- The right or 90 degree angle of the triangles should be lined up to the 12 o'clock and 6 o'clock positions of the block
- The triangle point will be longer than the block at the 3 o'clock and 9 o'clock positions. Do NOT trim.

Return completed blocks by the May 8, 2019 meeting.

If you take a kit and do not complete the block, please return the kit by the May 8, 2019 meeting.
